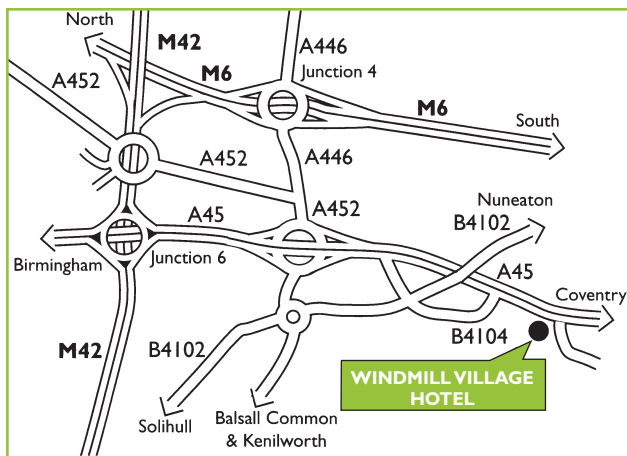

**Directions from M1 from the South**

Take junction 17 sign-posted M45 to Coventry/Birmingham. Stay on the M45 and then A45 for approximately 20 miles. The hotel is on the A45, 200 yards past the junction for the City Centre A4114.

**Directions from M1 from the North**

Take junction 23a sign-posted A42/M42 to Birmingham. Stay on the A42 and then M42 and then take junction 6 sign-posted A45 to Coventry. Take the slip road for the City Centre A4114. At the bottom of the slip road take the 5th exit from the roundabout back onto the A45 to Birmingham. The hotel is 200 yards on the left.

**Directions from M6, M40 and M42**

From M6 take junction 4 onto M42 to NEC & Airport. If coming from M40 proceed onto the M42 to the NEC & Airport. Take the slip road for the City Centre A4114. At the bottom of the slip road take the 5th exit from the roundabout back onto the A45 to Birmingham. The hotel is 200 yards on the left.

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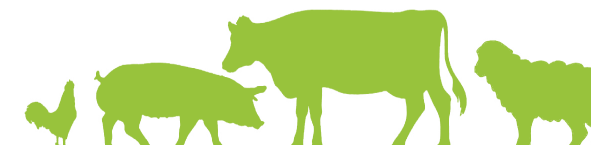

## INTRODUCTION

We are delighted to invite you to the Society of Feed Technologists (SFT) conference on topical and important pig topics. With a team of experienced international speakers of the highest quality we can look forward to each paper being informative, relevant and attractively presented. The conference will focus on highly relevant areas of pig production.

The decision made to leave the EU poses serious challenges to the UK pig industry and the conference commences with Mick Sloyan, AHDB examining the future prospects for the UK pig industry post Brexit. The results from the Edgar Pye Scholarship will be presented by Dr Sian Nichols, Nutreco, in a joint paper with Dr Sadie Douglas, Farmex, outlining early nutritional strategies to promote lifetime pig performance, while Manon Houben from The Netherlands, will discuss litter management for the new emerging super prolific pig stock.

On more basic technical topics Professor Mick Bailey, Bristol University will examine the Microbiome and the opportunities for improving health and performance and the potential for the development of a new generation of efficacious probiotics, while Dr Jaap Van Milgen, INRA will update on precision protein and amino acid interactions in pigs. The final paper by Dr Pinder Gill will report on a new management tool aimed at putting a monetary value on improvements in pig management.
