- Animal health and welfare
- Management of equine, companion and captive zoo animals
- Only theses adhering to this stated scope will be considered

GUIDELINES

- Two entries per Institution
- Open to animal science undergraduate students via institution entry
- Entries should relate to dissertations submitted July 2024 - June 2025
- PDF Format
- All entries must be submitted in UK English
- Entries will be shortlisted on the abstract provided with the thesis
- Entry deadline 31st July 2025

- Opportunity to present at the BSAS Annual Conference 2026
- Abstract printed in Proceedings
- Complimentary BSAS 2026 Delegate Conference Pass
- £150 towards travel and accommodation
